Councillor Pyke tabled a paper entitled "Bleadon Village community space improvement" which laid out the improvement proposals that embraced the area from the rear of the Jubilee Hall the Youth Club Building together with the amenity area immediately in front of the toilet block and the participating stakeholders. He indicated in order to secure the Sparkplug funding of £4,000 it had to be at least matched funded. The cost of the project would be £11,682.00 for which he would be seeking over two years a parish contribution of £5,232.00.

Resolved by four votes to one (Councillor Rob House dissenting – Councillor Keith Pyke not participating) that the Parish Council would support the "Sparkplug" Programme financially in the sum of £5,232.00 over two years. The larger percentage of the money £4,000 being drawn this financial year from the Village Improvement budget.
