## 2021 UN Food Systems Summit

August 30, 2021

The UN Food Systems Summit will take place on Thursday, September 23, 2021.

The event will be held during the UN General Assembly in New York and will take the form of a virtual event.

The Summit will follow the three-day Pre-Summit (https://unfoodsystems.org/) gathering in Rome last week (July 26-28), during which Amina J.
