Browse cases data for specific areas within the UK.

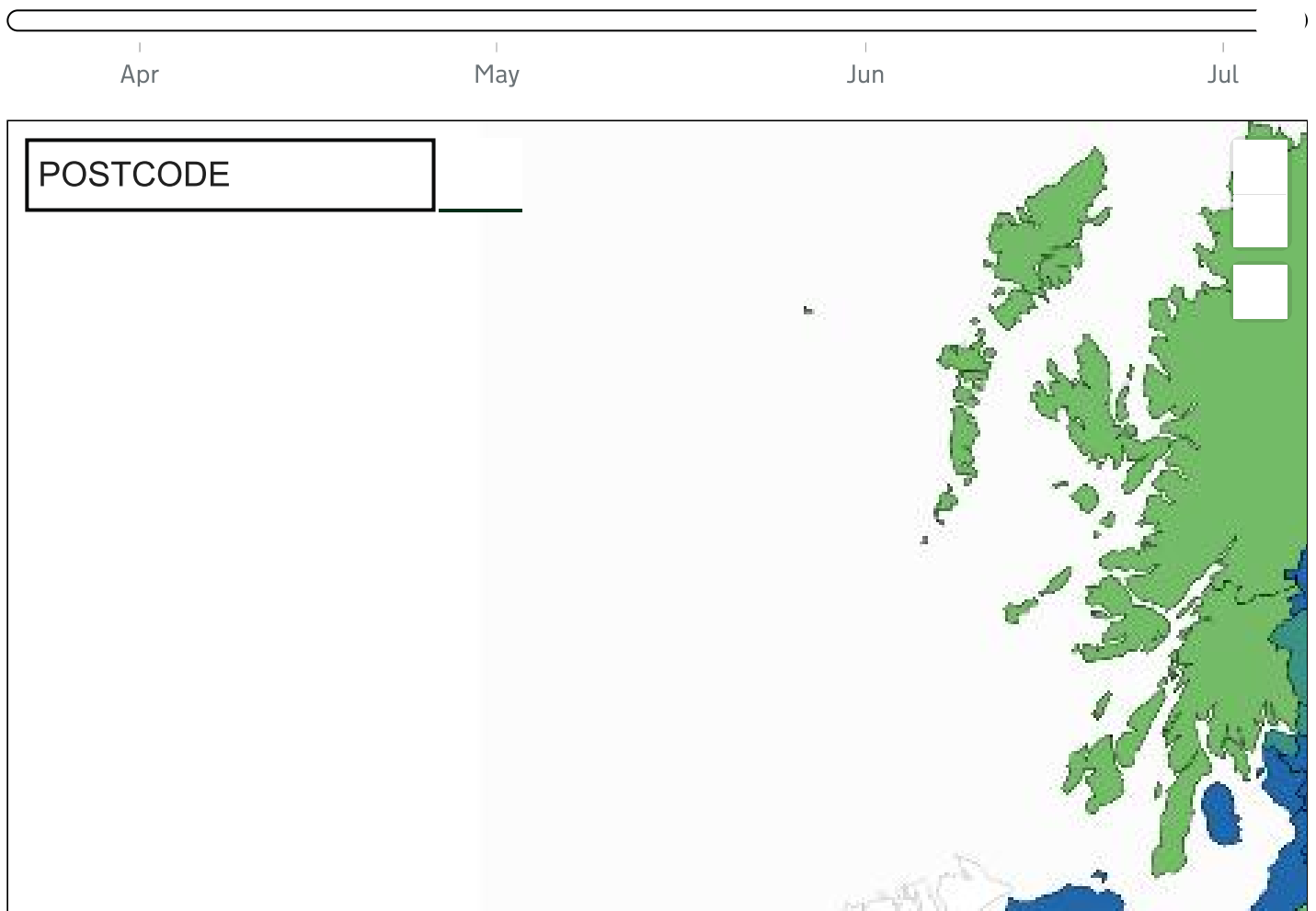
The map displays weekly data, which are updated everyday. Use the slider to select a week-ending date.

Local view: The default zoom level shows Upper Tier Local Authorities (UTLA). Zoom in for more details, including Lower Tier Local Authorities (LTLA) and Middle layer Super Output Areas (MSOA).

Suppressed rates: For smaller areas (eg MSOAs) with fewer than 3 cases, we do not show data. This is to protect individuals' identities.

More details: Click on an area to see more detailed cases data for the most recent time period available – including seven day case rates and direction of change. When zoomed to very small areas, data for Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales are not available.

Seven-day rolling rate of new cases by specimen date ending on **12 Dec 2020**





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Seven-day rates are expressed per 100,000 population and are calculated by dividing the seven day count by the area population and multiplying by 100,000.
