## What is R?

The reproduction number (R) is the average number of seconda produced by 1 infected person.

An R number of 1 means that on average every person who is infected will infect 1 other person, meaning the total number of new infections is stable.

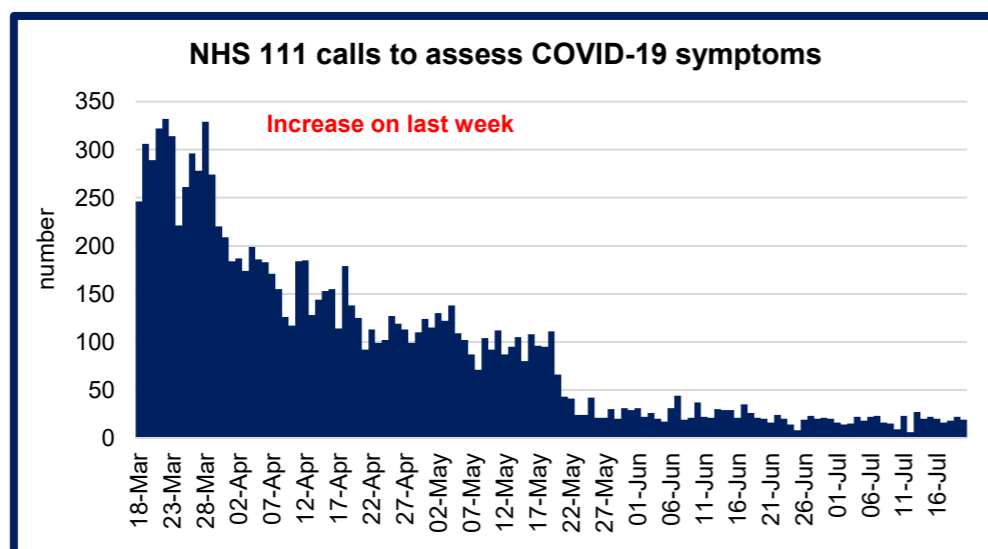

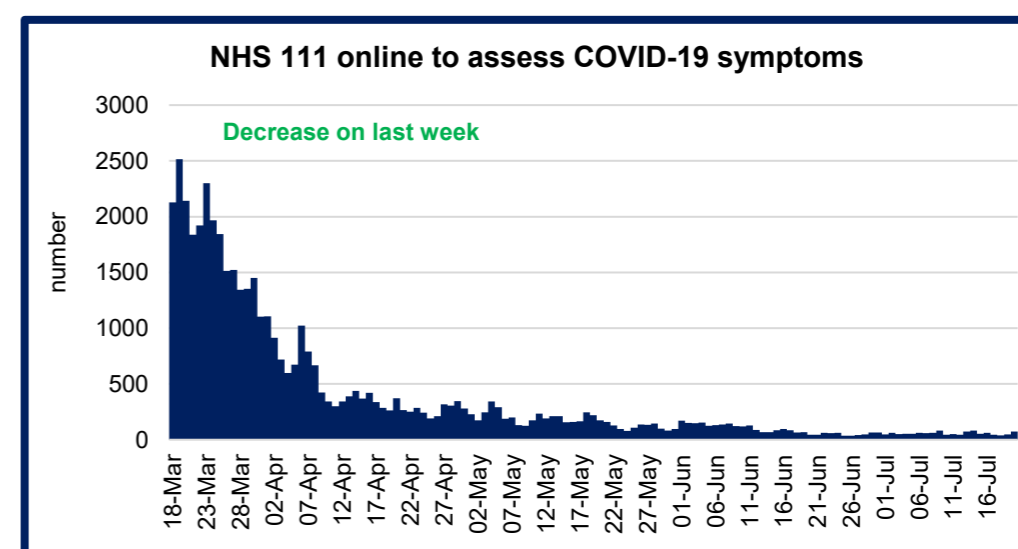
Bristol, North Somerset and South Glos CCG based calls to NHS 111 to assess COVID-19 symptoms

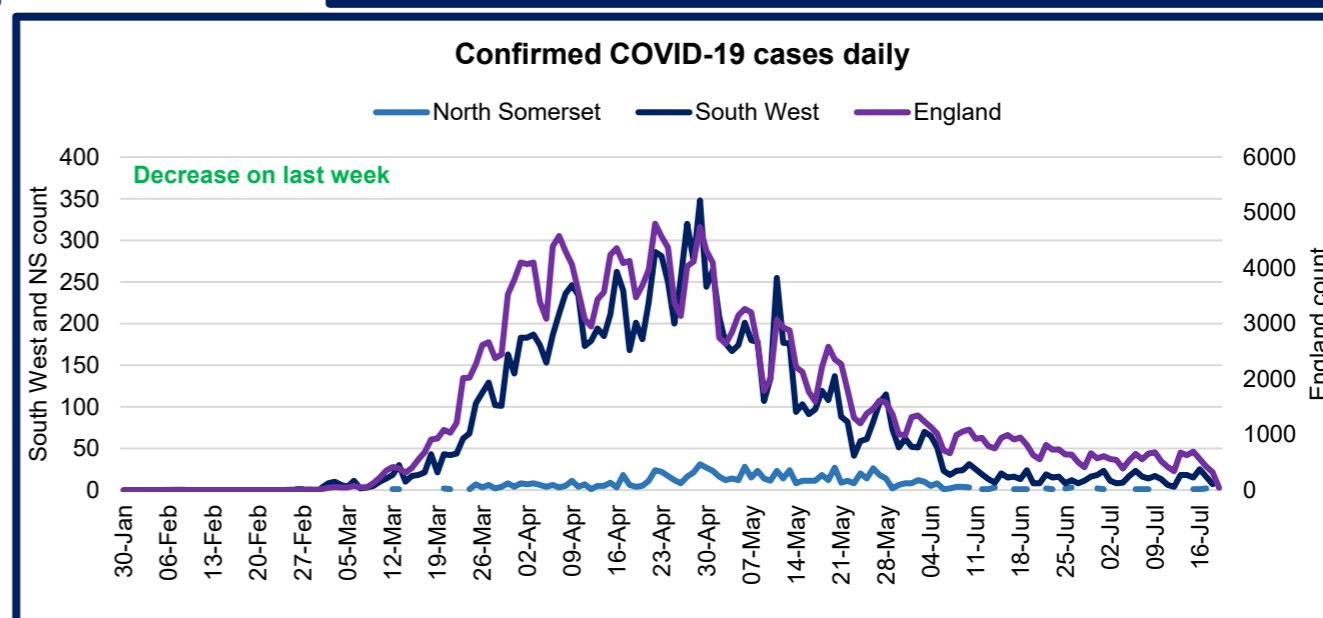
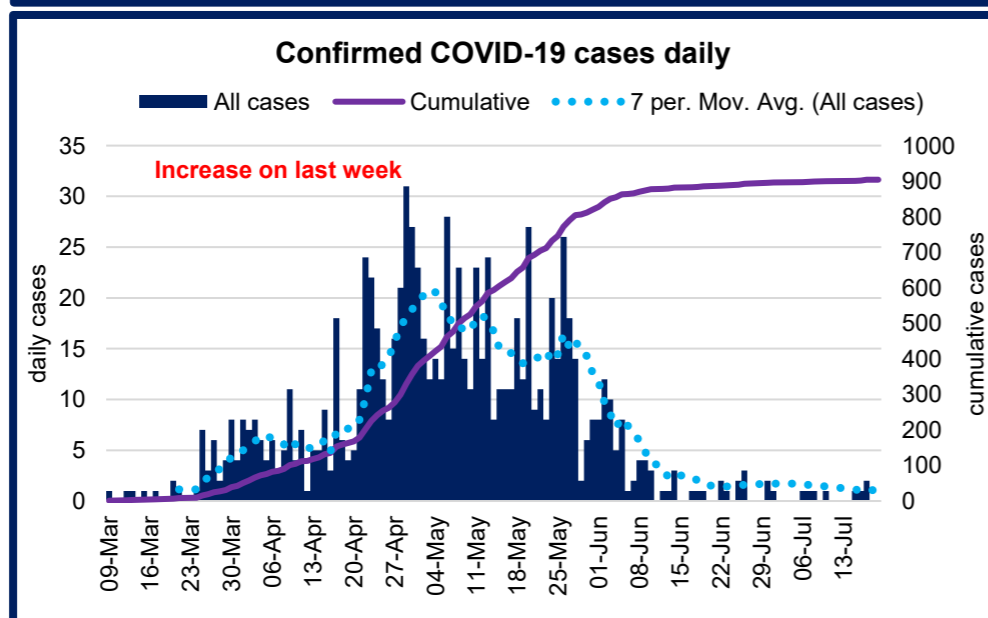

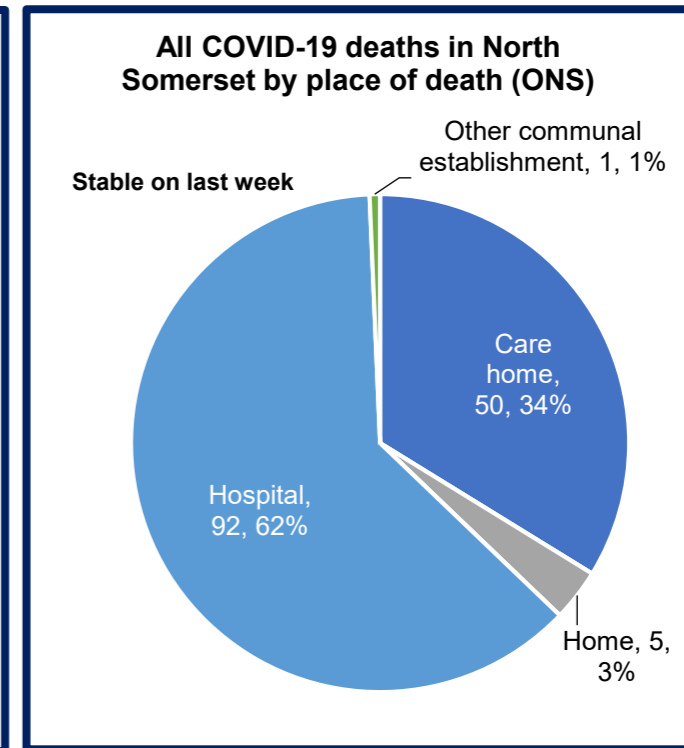

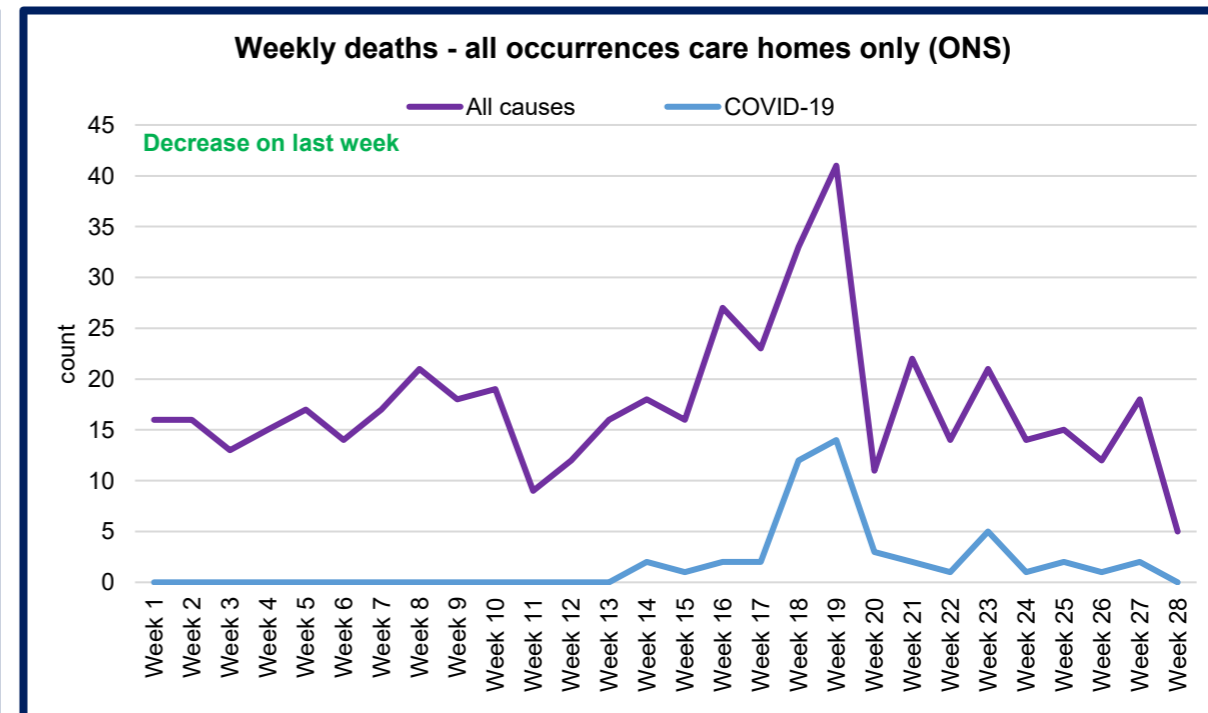
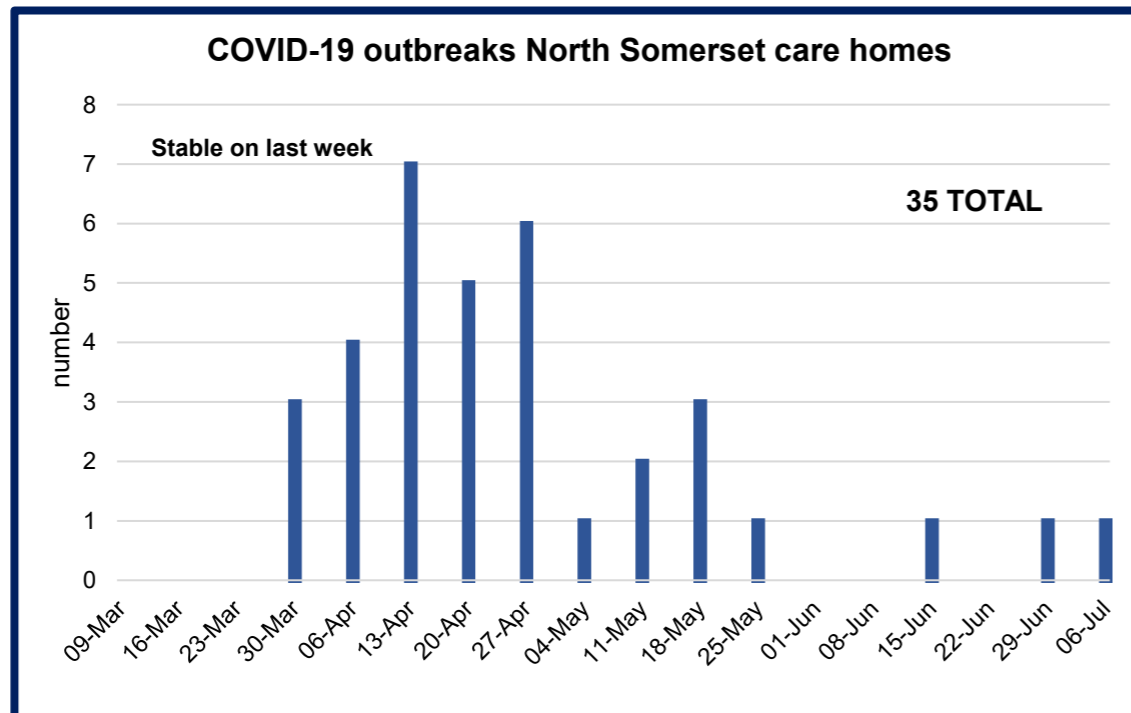

<p>This data shows the latest information relating to the triage of coronavirus symptoms triaged through <a href="#">NHS Pathways</a> by callers to NHS 111 and 999, and through <a href="#">NHS 111 online</a>. It reports the triages and completed online assessments which have received a potential coronavirus (COVID-19) final disposition, from 18 March 2020. This is a count of number of assessments, not the number of people.</p>

<p>Deaths and lab-confirmed case counts and rates for England and subnational areas are provided by Public Health England. COVID-19 cases are identified by taking specimens from people and sending these specimens to laboratories around the UK to be tested.
