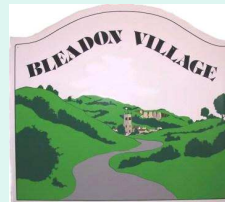

The Precept 2014/15

What is "The Precept"?

It is a sum of money that is requested by the Parish Council

and is paid by North Somerset District Council

In January of each year the Parish Council must decide



What its precept will be.....

The Precept

In simple terms it is the difference between :-

what the Council receives in - **INCOME**

and what it intends to spend - **EXPENDITURE**

From here on the Council has to work out

what it is required to spend during

the next twelve months - such as

General Maintenance



Village Improvements



Staff Costs



Administration



Grants

- What does this mean in real cash terms?
- How much is it going to cost a D Band House in the Village?
- What does that mean to an average household per week?
- Band D - 2014/15 = £ 522.60

£74.59 pa in 2013/14 = £1.43 pence per week

£72.71 pa in 2014/15 = £1.40 pence per week

Total Decrease per week per household for the year .03 pence
