



## Council Tax 2012/13

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Section Social and General Statistics

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This note contains key statistics on council tax levels in 2012/13 and a limited amount of analysis is provided. The main purpose of this note is to act as a reference document although more detailed analysis is available on request.

On 21 March 2012 the Department for Communities and Local Government (DCLG) released a comprehensive list of the levels of council tax charged by each local authority in England for 2012/13. The Welsh Assembly Government released similar information the following day. The Scottish Executive had previously announced that all Scottish Councils would be freezing council tax in 2012/13.

The average council tax for a band D household in 2012/13 is: £1,444 in England; £1,188 in Wales; and £1,149 in Scotland.

In England the average council tax for a band D household will rise by 0.3% on 2011/12. In Wales the average band D council tax will rise by 2.2% on 2011/12. Council tax levels have been frozen in Scotland.

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## 1 Introduction

The council tax was introduced as the primary source of collecting income from local residents by local authorities in England, Wales and Scotland in April 1993. This system replaced the Community Charge, which had in turn replaced Domestic Rating in April 1990.

There are 380 billing authorities in Great Britain responsible for collecting council tax to meet their own demands and the precepts levied by the lower tier Parish or Community Councils and higher tier County Councils, Joint Boards, Police and Fire Authorities.

The following table shows the property price range of each council tax band and the total number of chargeable dwellings in each band. There are eight valuation bands in England and Scotland and nine in Wales. Band I was introduced in Wales in April 2005 following the revaluation of domestic properties.

Local authorities set council tax levels by dividing the amount of money they aim to raise by the band D equivalent taxbase. The taxbase is calculated by weighting the number of dwellings in each band by the ratio to band D. The bills in each band are calculated according to a set ratio to band D.<sup>1</sup>

The average band D level of council tax is usually used for comparisons of tax levels set. It is, according to the DCLG, a definition that is widely regarded as a benchmark when comparing council tax levels in different areas or over time.<sup>2</sup> It compares the level of tax paid by households in similarly valued properties.

As only a minority of properties in each local authority are in band D, 15% in England, this measure does not show the average amounts of council tax payable by people in different

areas. Figures showing the average council tax per dwelling in each local authority are also published.

In different local authority areas the mix of dwellings may be significantly different to the national average giving rise to overall average bills which may vary considerably from the band D average. For example in Nottingham, where 92% of all chargeable dwellings were valued in bands A to C, the average band D bill is £1,614 compared with the average per dwelling of £1,019.

In general the council tax levels in this note include, where appropriate, the average of all the parish precepts levied across the entire area. Therefore in areas where parish precepts are levied the actual band D level paid by a household may not be the same as the band D figure shown here.

## 2 2012/13 council tax freeze grant

In October 2011, the Chancellor of the Exchequer announced that funding would be made available to help councils to freeze or reduce their council tax in 2012/13. Eligible authorities (billing authorities or higher tier precepting authorities) who froze or reduced their council tax level would receive a one-off grant, payable for one year.

See appendix 7 for a list of local authorities eligible for the council tax freeze grant, and whether the council tax level they set qualified them for the grant.

Of the 421 authorities eligible for the freeze grant, 358 (85%) froze or reduced their band D council tax in 2012/13; take up was lowest amongst police and fire authorities.

An individual household's council tax bill is determined by levels set by the local billing authority and other relevant higher tier and lower tier precepting authorities. In an area where eligible authorities have taken the 2012/13 council tax freeze grant, households may still see an increase in the bill they pay: this will be the case if the parish council has increased their council tax level.

Parish council's are not eligible for the 2012/13 council tax freeze grant. The average band D precept charged by a parish in 2012/13 will be £47.80; an increase of 4.2% on 2011/12. However, over one-quarter of billing authorities do not have any precepting parishes in their area.

### **3 The national picture**


#### **3.1 England**

In England the average band D council tax bill for 2012/13 is £1,444; a rise of 0.3% on 2011/12.

The average council tax bill in England per dwelling is £1,201 in 2012/13 compared with £1,196 in 2011/12, an increase of 0.4%. Average council tax per dwelling is significantly less than the average for a band D dwelling as two-thirds of dwellings are in bands A-C.

The rise in average band D council tax of 0.3% in 2012/13 follows an increase of less than 0.1% in 2011/12, and an increase of 1.8% in 2010/11. These represent the three lowest increases since council tax was introduced. Prior to 2010/11, the average annual increase in band D council tax was 5.9% per year.

**Average band D Council Tax, England, £**



Average band D council tax in 2012/13 is: £1,304 in London; £1,401 in other English metropolitan areas; and, £1,492 in English shire areas.

Welsh authorities were not offered financial support to freeze their council tax level in 2012/13. The average band D council tax bill in Welsh unitary authorities increased in 2012/13 by 2.2% on 2011/12; this was the largest increase of any class of authority. The next largest increase was in English unitary authorities (0.7%), followed by English shire districts (0.5%).

In 2012/13 the average band D council tax level decreased in Inner London (0.4%) and Outer London (0.2%) authorities, on 2011/12.



Council Tax Demands and Precepts Statistics, CIPFA

The average band D council tax in the North East (£1,525) is higher than in any other region; however, as 85% of chargeable dwellings in the North East are in bands A to C, the majority of households will be billed for less than this. London has the lowest average band D rate (£1,304) but also has the smallest proportion of chargeable dwellings in band A to C (44%).

The average council tax per dwelling varies from £1,381 in the South East to £1,052 in Yorkshire and Humber. The following chart shows the average band D and per dwelling council tax figures for each English region.

**Average council tax, 12/13, by region**



The following table shows the average band D tax level by political control of authority. Political control is defined as a party having a majority of councillors after the local elections held in May 2011. In practice a party may control the local authority with less than half of the councillors, as members from other parties may vote with the largest party. However for these purposes an authority where the largest party doesn't have a majority of councillors is considered to be under No Overall Control (NOC).

Due to the fact that some averages have been calculated from very few observations it is hard to draw firm conclusions, however the figures suggest:

#### *Average band D council tax*

- Amongst metropolitan districts, band D bills were highest in the average Labour local authority and lowest in Conservative ones.
- Average band D council tax bills in London were highest amongst Lib Dem local authorities and lowest in Conservative run councils.
- Unitary authorities with NOC had the highest bills.
- Shire district bills were highest in Labour areas and lowest in Conservative areas.
- All but one county council is Conservative controlled.


#### *Average council tax per dwelling*

- Amongst metropolitan districts, bills were lowest in the average Labour local authority, with Conservative local authorities charging the highest levels.
- Average council tax bills in London were highest amongst Lib Dem local authorities and lowest in Labour run councils.
- The average Conservative controlled council set the highest bills for unitary authorities while the lowest were set Lib Dem authorities.
- There is one shire district under 'other' political control; this had the highest bill amongst shire districts.

### 3.2 Wales

In Wales the average band D council tax for 2012/13 is £1,188. This includes £998 for local services (county and community council precepts) and £190 for police authorities. The average band D council tax has increased by 2.2% on 2011/12.

Average band D Council Tax, Wales, £




Pembrokeshire authority has billed the lowest band D council tax in 2012/13 (£945), followed by Newport (£1,023). The highest council tax charged is in Blaenau Gwent (£1,463) with Neath Port Talbot (£1,416) the next highest. ### 3.3 Scotland

Council tax levels in Scotland were frozen by all of the 32 councils in 2012/13;<sup>3</sup> this is the fifth successive council tax freeze. In Glasgow council tax levels have not been changed since 2005/06. In three other local authority areas council tax levels have been unchanged since 2006/07: Angus; Midlothian; and, Dundee.

The chart below shows the average level of band D council tax in Scotland in each year since the introduction of the system in 1993/94. The average band D council tax bill in Scotland in 2012/13 is £1,149.



The highest level of band D council tax charged is in Aberdeen (£1,230) and the lowest billing authority was Eilean Siar (£1,024). See appendix 6 for historical information on the average band D council tax levels of each billing local authority in Scotland.

## 4 The local picture in Great Britain

The following table shows the 20 billing authorities with the highest levels of average band D council tax in 2012/13. These are the levels billed by the authorities and include all precepts. Seven of the high-billing authorities were single-tier authorities with the remaining 13 two-tier shire authorities.

Rutland, (Conservative controlled unitary) had the highest levels of average band D council tax. Of these twenty billing authorities: eight are Labour controlled; seven are Conservative; four are NOC, and, one is Lib Dem.

Five of the billing authorities in the list below are districts in Conservative controlled Nottinghamshire county council. The combined county council, fire and police authority precepts in Nottinghamshire were the highest amongst English shire counties.

The following table shows those billing authorities with the lowest levels of average band D council tax in 2012/13. These are the levels charged by the billing authorities and include all precepts.

Wandsworth and Westminster (both Conservative) have the lowest levels of average band D council tax. Of these twenty authorities, all single-tier, eleven are Scottish; five are inner London boroughs; and, the remainder are Welsh. 10 of the authorities have no overall control; four are Conservative controlled; four are represented by councillors not affiliated to a mainstream political party; and, one is Labour controlled. The remaining one is the City of London which has no elected members.

## 5 Council tax: local referendums

For 2012/13 no authority has set an increase in council tax that will result in a local referendum being held.

The Localism Act 2011 abolished council tax capping and replaced it with a system which makes planned increases in council tax, above a certain threshold, subject to a local binding council tax referendum. A referendum must be held where an authority's council tax increase is higher than the principles approved by the House of Commons. The principles for 2012/13 were set out in a written statement by the Parliamentary Under Secretary of State for Department of Communities and Local Government, as follows:<sup>4</sup>

A local authority will be required to seek the approval of their local electorate in a referendum if, compared with 2011-12, they set council tax increases that exceed:

4% for police authorities, and single purpose fire & rescue authorities;

3.75% for the City of London; and

3.5% for other principal authorities.

In the case of the Greater London authority, which sets two precepts, it will be required to hold a referendum if, compared with 2011-12, it sets increases that exceed either or both of:

4% for its adjusted relevant basic amount

3.75% for its unadjusted relevant basic amount

For principal authorities<sup>5</sup> the 3.5% 'trigger point' is calculated on the relevant basic amount of council tax, which excludes levies and special levies relating to outside bodies such as joint waste authorities or joint transport authorities.

## **6 Appended tables**

Appendix 7 provides a list of English local authorities eligible for the 2012/13 council tax freeze grant, showing the % change in their band D council tax level, and whether or not this level has qualified them for the grant.
