PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER NO. 2 2012

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of the Order and of the public it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The applicants have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Lake Farm/Lakeside Barns, Shiplate Road, Bleadon and shown by a bold continuous line on the Map No. PPO 133 contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which North Somerset District Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highway mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. Notwithstanding this Order Western Power Distribution shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely: they shall for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they had immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted.
3. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situated at Lake Farm/Lakeside Barns, Bleadon described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Map No. PPO 133 contained in this Order.

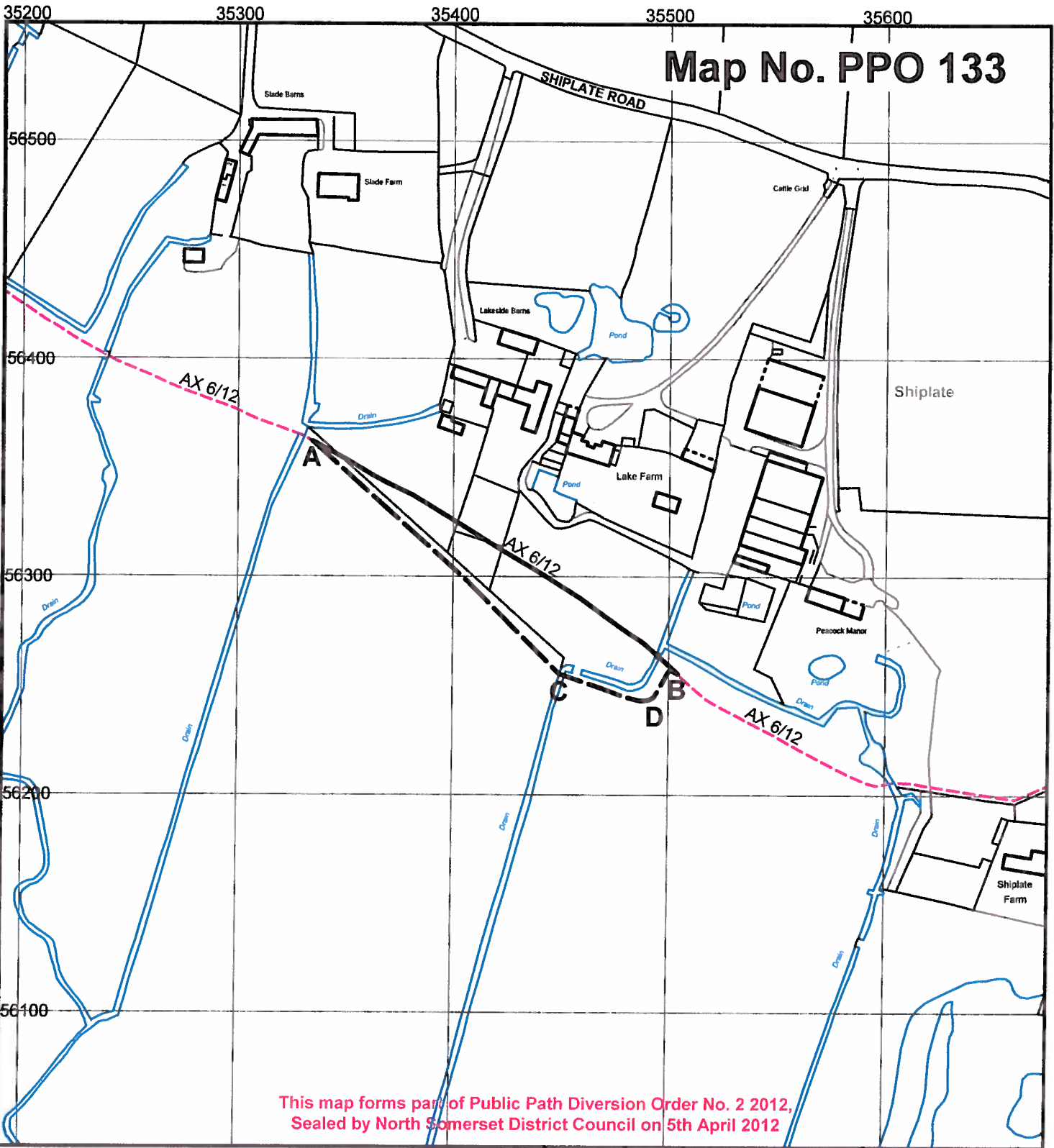
DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

That part of Public Footpath AX 6/12 in the Parish of Bleadon from point A (Grid Reference ST 35335 56362) running in an east, south easterly direction for approximately 201 metres to point B (Grid Reference 35504 56255) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 133.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF ALTERNATIVE HIGHWAYS

A Public Footpath in the Parish of Bleadon from point A (Grid Reference ST 35335 56362) running in a south easterly direction for approximately 158 metres to a culvert at point C (Grid Reference ST 35451 56255) then in a generally east, south easterly direction for approximately 45 metres to point D (Grid Reference ST 35493 56245) then in a generally north, north easterly direction for approximately 19 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 35504 56255). The footpath will have a width of 2 metres, as shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 133.

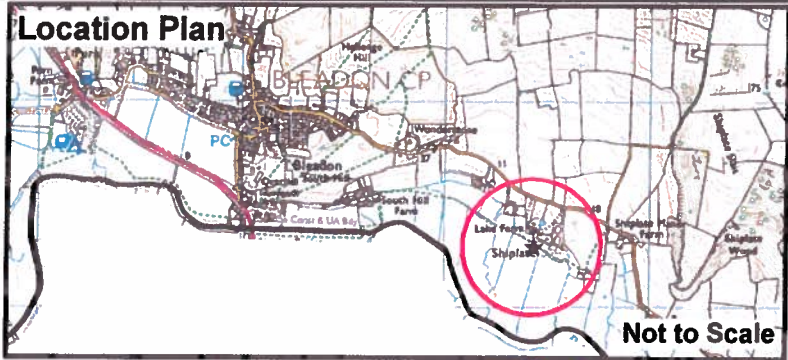

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER NO. 2 2012

On 12 September 2013 North Somerset Council confirmed the above Order, made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert that part of Public Footpath AX 6/12 in the Parish of Bleadon within the District of North Somerset as described below.

That part of Public Footpath AX 6/12 from point A (Grid Reference ST 35335 56362) running in an east, south easterly direction for approximately 201 metres to point B (Grid Reference 35504 56255) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 133 to:

A new path from point A (Grid Reference ST 35335 56362) running in a south easterly direction for approximately 158 metres to a culvert at point C (Grid Reference ST 35451 56255) then in a generally east, south easterly direction for approximately 45 metres to point D (Grid Reference ST 35493 56245) then in a generally north, north easterly direction for approximately 19 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 35504 56255). The footpath will have a width of 2 metres, as shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 133.

A copy of the confirmed Order and Order map has been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Reception desk, North Somerset Council Offices, Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare BS23 1UJ from 9.00am to 4.30pm Mondays to Thursdays and 9.00am to 4.00pm on Fridays, or may be viewed on the Council's Web site www.n-somerset.gov.uk/notices. Copies are also available for inspection at Bleadon Post Office and Country Stores, Purn Way, Bleadon, Weston-super-Mare BS24 0QF during normal opening hours (9.00am to 5.30pm Monday to Friday and 9.00am to 12.30pm on Saturdays).

The Order came into force on 11 October 2013 but, if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 6 November 2013, make an application to the High Court.
