

## Why I will not be giving my children the **Covid vaccine**

was appalled but not shocked last week when the Medicines and Health Products Regulatory Authority granted approval for "emergency use" of the Pfizer-BioNTech Covid-19 vaccine in children aged 12 to 15. Over the past six months the age groups targeted for jabs have dropped from the over-70s through middle age down to children, with no scientific explanation of why we are medicating an entire population against a virus that contributed to the deaths of those with an average age of 80.

There is no "emergency" from which children require saving: the <u>risk of Covid-19</u> to them is tiny. The infection fatality rate in this age group is practically zero, and most remain asymptomatic or experience only mild symptoms. Do we now live in a
