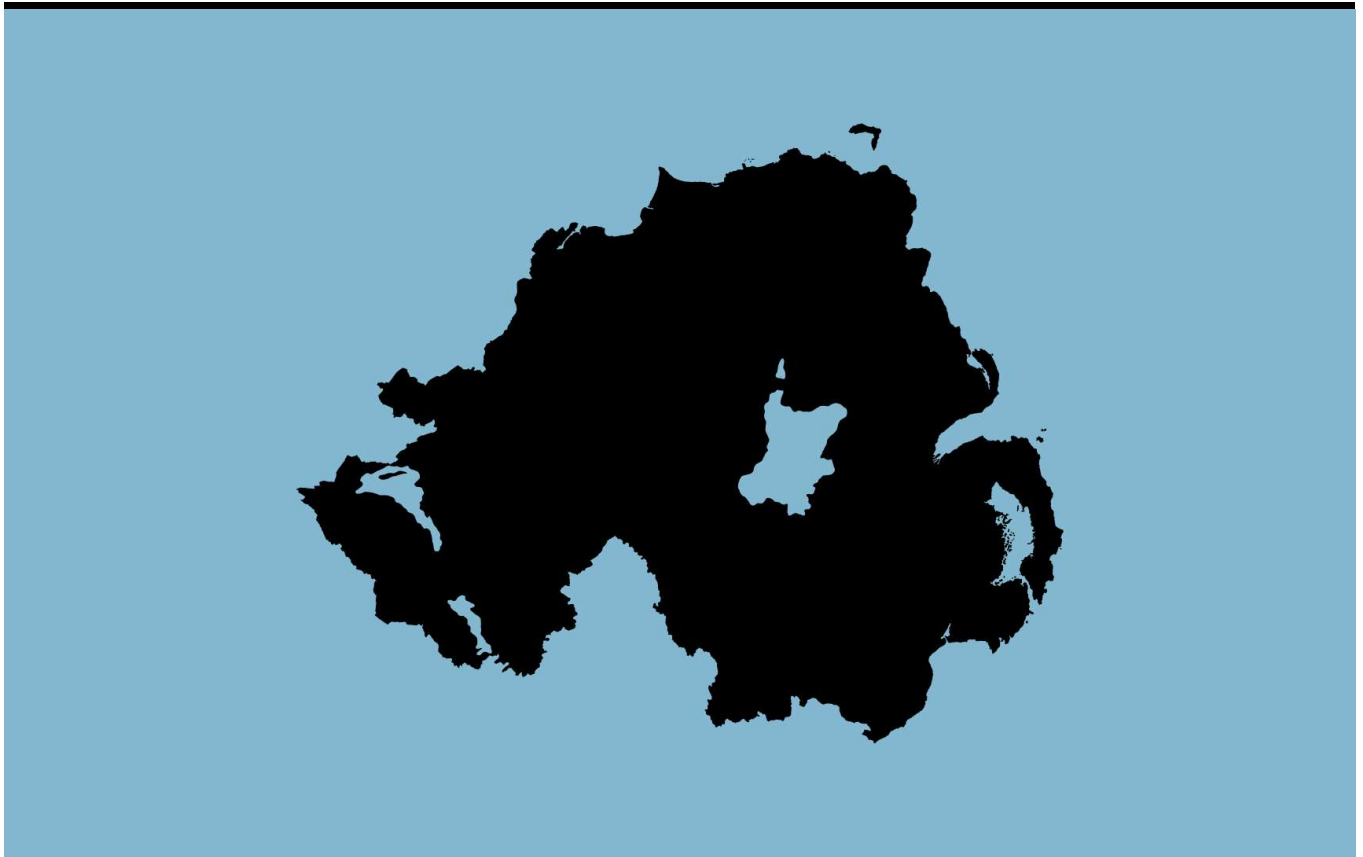

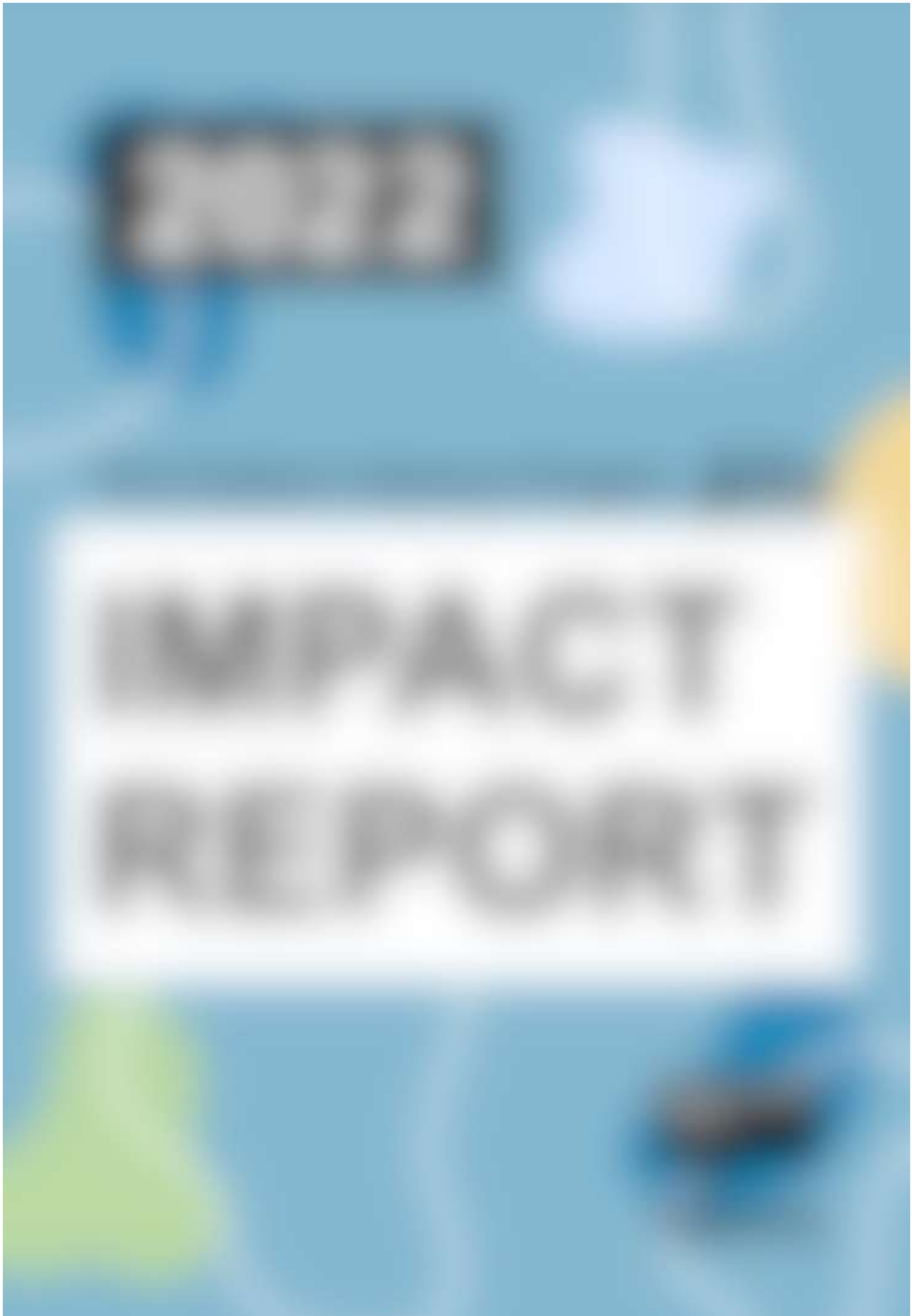


2021 Impact Report
