During Holy week there will be simple services in church on each evening at 8pm

On Maundy Thursday, 24th March, at 7.30pm, we will be holding an Eucharist with foot washing followed by a vigil as we spend time with Jesus in Gethsemane.

On **Good Friday** we will be holding an informal service of reflection at 10.15am © as we walk the way of the cross with Jesus and then at 2pm we will keep the final hour together.

After the sun has set on **Easter Eve**, 26th March, we will be holding a series of short services and events as we begin our celebrations: Alleluia He is Risen! Here's the Plan:

7pm: Quiet reflection inside the church.

7.30pm : New Life and New Fire, we light the fire outside the church, light our candles from it and bring the light in. Alleluia He is Risen!

When he came to Jerusalem people were very happy because he had come.






Jesus said that for hope and life to grow, we need to trust God and care for each other.


Sometimes this is hard and scary.
