## Q: Can any council now just use the General Power of Competence?

A: No The General Power of Competence does not apply to parish meetings and a parish council needs to have a fully qualified Clerk with the latest CiLCA qualification and 2/3 of the councillors need to have been elected by a normal election process (NOT co-opted) or they cannot use the power.
